August 4: Why we're unhappy -- the expectation gap | Nat Ware | TEDxKlagenfurt. Why are bronze medalists often happier than silver medalists? "The first step to being happy is to understand why we're often unhappy," says economist and entrepreneur Nat Ware. In an entertaining and enlightening talk, Nat shows that we're bad predictors of happiness, and explains why this is. We make decisions based on actual outcomes, but our happiness depends on relative outcomes. It's near impossible for reality to live up to our expectations. It is this expectation gap – the gap between our expectations and reality – that Nat argues is a key reason we're unhappy. Nat challenges us to start taking happiness seriously. The answer is not to simply lower our expectations, but rather to change the very way in which we make decisions. Our discussion will be facilitated by Brian Warren
